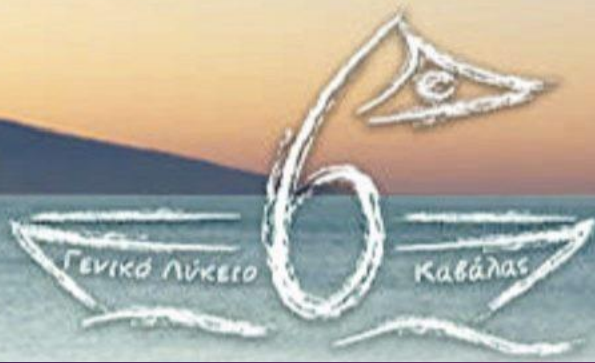

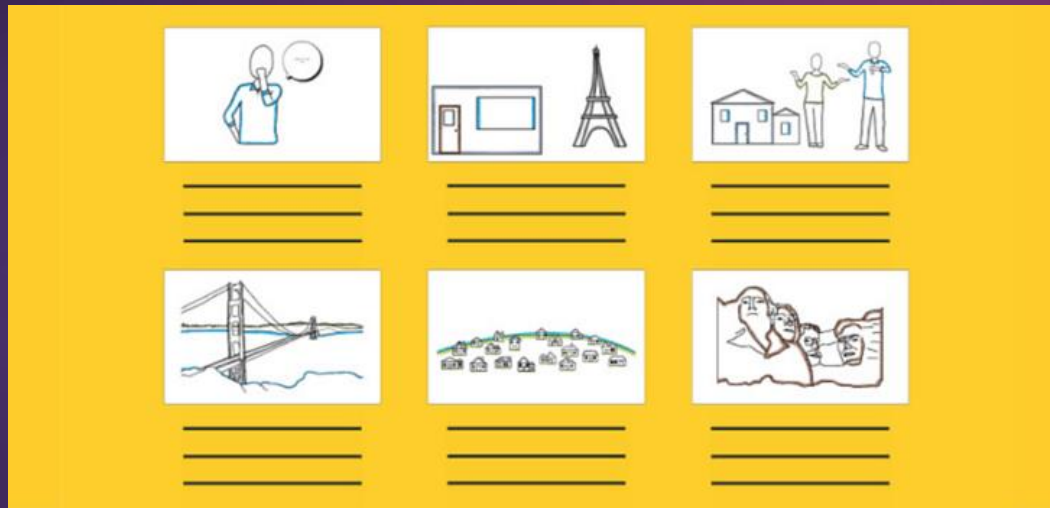

What is a Storyboard?



A storyboard is a graphic organizer that plans a narrative.

Storyboards are a **powerful way** to **visually present information**;

the linear direction of the cells is perfect for storytelling, explaining a process, and showing the passage of time.

At their core, storyboards are a **set of sequential drawings** to tell a story. By breaking a story into linear, bite-sized chunks, it allows the author to focus on each cell separately, without distraction.

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Benefits of the storyboard

- ▶ One advantage of using storyboards is that it allows the creator to experiment with changes in the storyline to evoke stronger reaction or interest.
- ▶ Flashbacks are often the result of sorting storyboards out of chronological order to help build suspense and interest.

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Benefits of the storyboard

- ▶ The production can plan the movie in advance.
- ▶ In this step, things like the type of camera shot, angle, and blocking of characters are decided.



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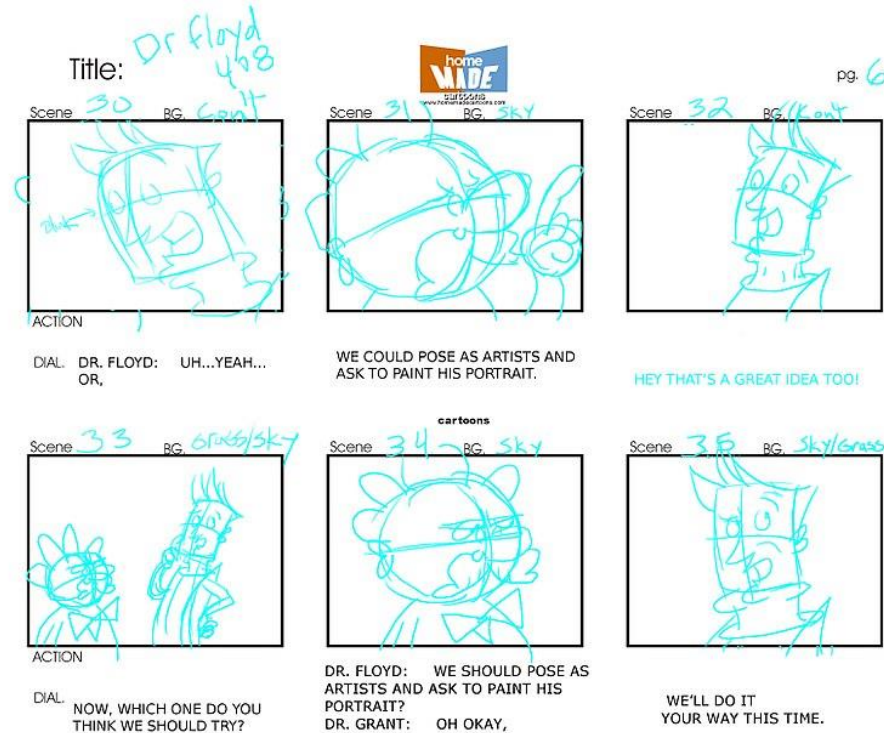


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Benefits of the storyboard

- The process of visual thinking and planning allows a group of people to brainstorm together, placing their ideas on storyboards and then arranging the storyboards on the wall.
- This fosters more ideas and generates consensus inside the group.



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Creation of storyboard

The main characteristics of a storyboard are:

- ▶ **Visualize** the storytelling.
- ▶ **Focus** the story and the timing in several key frames (very important in animation).
- ▶ **Define** the technical parameters: description of the motion, the camera, the lighting, etc.
